DAVOSA Audrey Quartz

In 1961 as New York party girl Holly Golightly in "Breakfast at Tiffany's", the actress wrote fashion history. A simple, black dress, long satin gloves, a striking multi-stranded pearl choker with a large rhinestone brooch was all it took to gain a place in the collective fashion memory for all time.

The DAVOSA Audrey Quartz Collection is devoted to this fashion icon. Large and round, the flat stainless steel case is reminiscent of her legendary sunglasses, while mother-of-pearl and

zircon gems on the face and bezel symbolise her timeless elegance. The light-hearted, delicate touch comes from the fine satin-leather straps, specially made by hand for DAVOSA in a small leather goods manufacturer's. Instead of a sweep second-hand, the movement has an offset second-hand close to the '6', which accentuates its looks in an outstanding fashion. Time for you too to feel a little like "Audrey"!
